CANCELS FALL GARDEN TOUR**

Galveston, Texas - Due to the exceptional drought conditions currently affecting Galveston Island, the East End Historical District Association Board of Directors has voted to cancel the upcoming 3rd Annual Fall Garden Tour, scheduled for October 8th, 2011.

The combination of watering restrictions, extreme heat and lack of rainfall has taken a toll on gardens throughout Galveston, including those chosen for this year's tour. While rain remains a possibility, the lack of any forecast changes as well as the possibility of even more restrictive watering rules were two reasons the board chose to cancel the event at this time.

Tickets will be available at The Grand 1894 Opera House in Galveston starting on Saturday, October 1st.
